3. Purpose of data processing

The data are processed for the selection of scholarship holders.

4. Legal basis

The legal basis for the processing is Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b DSGVO.

5. Storage location and duration

The data will be kept for six months after the selection of the scholarship holders. In the case of successful applications, the data will be retained as long as necessary for the implementation of the scholarship.

6. Recipients and authorized persons

The data will not be passed on to third parties.

7. Rights of the data subjects

Under the conditions of Art. 15-18, Art. 20 DSGVO, you have a right to information, to the correction or deletion of your personal data and to the restriction of processing as well as to data portability. Your right to erasure depends, among other things, on whether the data concerning you is still needed to fulfill legal tasks. You also have the right to lodge a complaint about the processing of your personal data with a data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 DSGVO). The Federal Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (BfDI) is responsible for the Prussian Cultural Heritage Foundation.
